After last year's Susan G. Komen Des Moines Affiliate Race for the Cure it became apparent to event organizers that much of the waste generated could be recycled. In August 2007, Diane Faris, 2007 Race Chair, contacted Area Resource Specialist, Shelly Codner. Codner was asked to coordinate recycling efforts. Working with the race committee, this will be the first year of *Recycling At The Race*.

the anticipated diversion of material from this event is estimated to be between 5,000 to 10,000 lbs. These materials include all cardboard and all plastic bottles generated before, during and after the race.
