

REGION XII RPA TAC MINUTES

November 4, 2020

I. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

A. STBG Application FY 2022-2025

Whitaker review fund balances and recommended that STBG application be accepted until January 29, 2021.

B. TA Applications – FY 2022-2025

Whitaker reviewed the TA fund balance and very little funding is available until 2023. The consensus of the committee was to accept TA applications until January 29, 2021.

C. Trail Counters

Whitaker discussed that the COG's trail counters were old, corroded and in need of replacement. The consensus of the committee was that these provide valuable data and should be replaced.

An update to the Region XII Public Participation Plan is being drafted and will be presented after January 1.

E. Western Iowa Transit Ridership Survey

The WIT ridership survey is being distributed as part of the Passenger Transportation Plan update.

F. News from IDOT

Schultz reported that Zack Gunsolley was the new “Brian Catus”. IA 141 from Manning west to US59 will be done next year. IA 141 in Manning will see a diamond grinding project and go from a 4 lane to a 3 lane.

G. Other

Krauel reported that the North West Street STBG project was recently completed using high performance asphalt.
